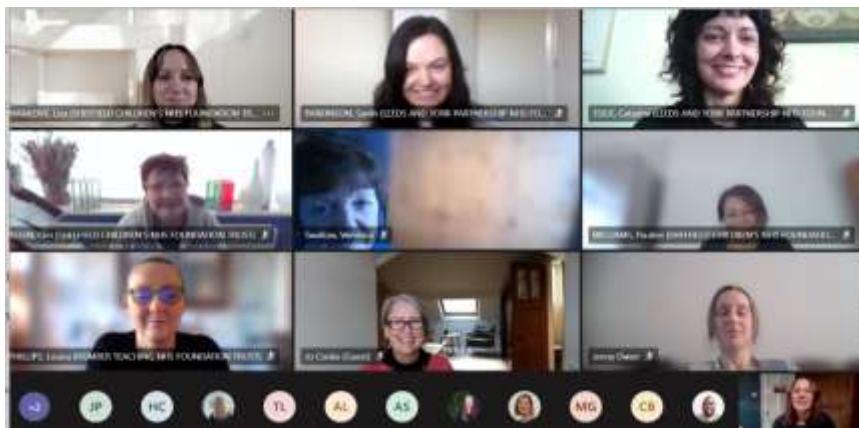


0-19 Research Network (CRN Yorkshire & Humber)
