Requirements:

The lecturer submission must be made using the iHV submission form to be accepted for entry. This details:

- Name of HEI, department providing the SCPHN-HV programme and declaration of cohort size
- Full name, contact details and signature of lecturer
- Full name, contact details and signature of the supporting line manager
- Title and written abstract prepared by the lecturer (max 500 words)
- Disclaimer confirming the submission is the lecturer's own work and has not been submitted elsewhere.

The abstract should:

Present an example of a teaching and learning initiative which demonstrates leadership in strengthening the quality of educational provision for SCPHN health visiting students.

NOTES

The judging panel will be looking for teaching and learning strategies informed by evidence and that demonstrate an impact on educational experiences of SCPHN health visiting students working with babies, children and families.

This will include factors known to support effective learning:

- 1. Partnerships with students
- 2. Evidence-informed practice
- 3. Equitable and accessible learning opportunities
- 4. Collaborative action
- 5. Leadership in education
- 6. Assessment of impact

The winning lecturer will be notified early October 2025. The award includes a complimentary place at the iHV Leadership Conference in London, Wednesday 3 December 2025*, where the successful lecturer will be invited to present their innovation and accept an iHV Award.
